Business Arising – No BA

Secretary Report – Secretary not in attendance.

Beacon & Competition – B.E. Rita Anderson to be 100 this year. Proposed that she be honoured in The Beacon.

Planning – Brief report of garage at the access to the village. Site noted as being expansive but within previously granted planning. T.E. Noted Framework erected at Crowwood, no planning apps have been noted. Northern Corridor Community Forum requested a list of items that CCC normally consider. This has been provided.

Environmental – C.W. not in attendance.

Roads and Lighting – Drains have been cleared on Station Road. A.T. noted that roadworks not backfilled to reinstate road properly. S,D. Traffic assessment of village carried out. No results have been shared. S.D. has been in contact with North Lan (Paul Dunn).

Cumbernauld Road/Station Road scheduled for resurfacing. B.R. Traffic counts on Drumcavel Road took place at mid-day.

B.E. read a release from NHS regarding the Lanrig Park Clinic.

AOCB – Movement of the defibrillator to Chryston Parish Church, if approved by them, to provide wider coverage. BE has applied for additional grant so f £650 to facilitate. Alternative locations are being investigated.

Community Notice Board – C.L. offered to provide refresh for layout.

B.E. expressed a need to have greater representation of the Community Council with inclusion of Mollinsburn
