Business Arising

Planning

Block of flats proposed behind old Manse (at bar). 12 residences. Need view of the character of the proposed development but view was that this is over development. BE will prepare and submit objection.

Environmental

NLC will no longer maintain community planters. SD has replanted. Possible sponsor/local businesses to support (feast/Italian/opticians). General discussion on making the village look better with time frame of Spring 2023. Interest could vary but SD would progress with possible locations and CW will check for what permissions are required.

Roads and Lighting

Bus Shelter – Pane missing – SD

Notice board – Polycarb damaged by solvent used to remove graffiti (raised by BE) and needs to be replaced. CW advised that NLC contact is Peter McNally (?)

Community Police

CCC needs regular updates. BR volunteered to pursue regular contact. BE to provide contacts.

Finance

RB provided report on accounts. Some receipts outstanding for audit of prizes. RB will have signed receipt of cash prizes being passed. Gala day brick-a-brac stall raised a total of £245 inc. cash donation for the Beacon Community Fund..

Beacon Community Fund

BE felt that this was not effectively promoted at the gala day. (need more detail)

Vice Chair

Due to Claire Williams stepping down since being elected as a councillor the post had become vacant. BE nominated CL, BR seconded, motion was passed by committee.

General Discussion

Flowershow. BE reluctant to garden competition as it may disadvantage and disengage some residents. Possibly something more community lead would be appropriate. The Chryston Horticultural Society seems to become inactive. CW will reach out to see what could be done. If NL in Bloom doesn't occur, perhaps something could be done focused on the September weekend.

Meeting Venue. The Hub Café at the Parish Church provides a more suitable environment. This will be retained until Christmas 2022 to test whether the time table of events works out with the CC scheduled meetings.

Defibulator. Require to map locations of units to see where else is appropriate and accessible. These locations can then be shown on the noticeboard via a community map.

Social Media. CW will send another invite to CL for Admin on the Facebook page.

AOCB

20 mph Zone. CL suggested that the village should be a 20 mph zone. CL will contact Transport Scotland to see how this could be progressed and what the implications are.

MoorPark. Artist impression has been shared on social media but no formal plans have been shared with the community council.
