Minutes of meeting held on 20th May at Chryston Parish Church

Chair Remarks - The chair welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Minutes of previous meeting - Adoption was proposed by N. Corrigan and seconded by R. Boyd.

Planning – No decision has been made yet on the retrospective Change of Use application for the Old Bank Café.

Parking and congestion continue to have a detrimental effect on the area and concerns about cumulative development effects were raised. The problem is exacerbated by people using Muirhead as a park and ride carpark. It was suggested that the community council could request some air quality data for the area from North Lanarkshire Council.
