Minutes of meeting held on 27th January 2024 at Chryston Parish Church

Chair Remarks - The chair welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Minutes of previous meeting - Adoption was proposed by N. Corrigan and seconded by B. Rice.

Business Arising – None.

Secretary Report – Several submissions have been received regarding the Local Place Plan. No other correspondence received this month.

Planning – No new developments noted.

Finance - R. Boyd presented the monthly accounts. Outstanding grants from NLC are progressing and should be resolved soon.

Environment - No activity in the community garden due to weather.

Community Police Report – 29 incidents were reported to Police across the Chryston, Muirhead, Mount Ellen and Mollinsburn area during November. A total of 10 crimes were recorded with the breakdown as follows:

One incident being investigated relates to a communications offence where phone calls have been made to a business premises, this accounts for 3 separate crimes.

Roads and Lighting – The keep left sign on the bend of Lindsaybeg Rd has been reported but not yet fixed.

Pavement parking continues to cause problems in the area. Cllr. Williams will liaise with police about traffic issues. Members of the public are encouraged to report instances of dangerous parking to the police.

Beacon Fund - Nothing pending.

Beacon - Thanks to R. Boyd for his hard work in the latest issue of the Beacon newsletter which was sent out just before Christmas.

AOCB – A0 maps of the area will be printed and made available in the library and warm spaces venue(s) to allow members of the public to submit suggestions for the LPP. R. Boyd and C. Little will create poster and flyer designs for use on noticeboards and possibly a leaflet drop. M. Robertson volunteered to review some sample LPPs and start work on a structure for Chryston's document.

The issue of there being only one key for the noticeboards and the difficulty of obtaining spares/copies was raised again. Cllr. Williams will make inquiries.
